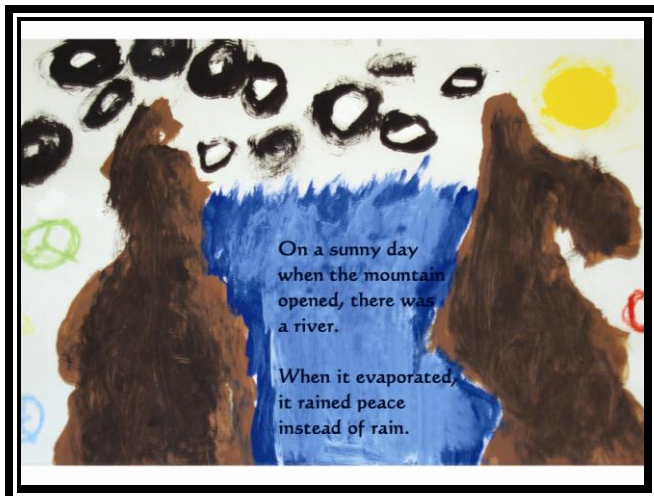

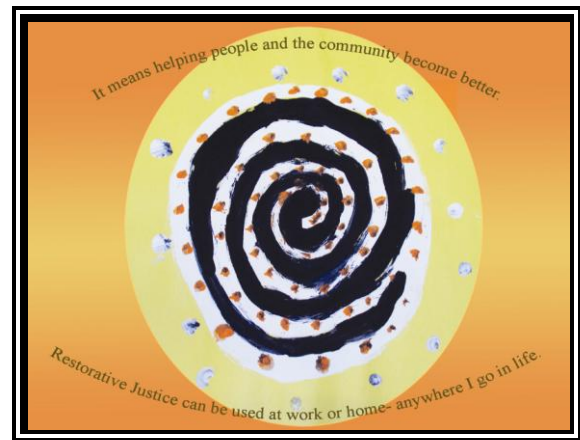
THIRD ANNUAL RJ ARTS INITIATIVE RECEPTION!!

restorative justice (RJ) related activities.



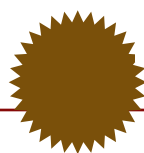
For three years the Central Michigan Restorative Justice Initiative has hosted an Arts Initiative in which students who have participated in RJ create artwork expressing what RJ means to them. We feature their artwork and recognize each artist or performer with an "Arts for RJ" certificate at the reception. Some pieces, like those you see here, are then selected to appear on CMRJI publications and note cards.



We encourage families, friends and RJ supporters to come celebrate these young people's artistry and to learn more about the restorative justice process.

This year's reception will feature performances from a number of students who participated in RJ interventions this year. Guests can enjoy these performances over the course of the evening while creating their own artwork—illustrating the pages of a community book on restorative justice. In addition, participants will be invited to learn more about RJ, take part in a Circle or watch RJ videos developed by the Lansing School District and Resolution Services Center.
